Health and wellness content is increasingly held to a clinical standard, by readers, by regulators, and by the platforms that decide whether it ranks. A physician review adds a specific, defensible layer that generic editing cannot: verification against clinical evidence, and a check for the kind of safety omission that only becomes obvious once you know what to look for. A sample report is available on request, showing this process run against a live, published article.

<b>Free First Review</b>	Send a sample draft and the first review is free, so you can evaluate the quality and see the value for your client base before committing to anything.	<b>\$0</b>
<b>Physician Byline</b>	A "Reviewed by a Physician" credit line with name and credentials, added on top of a Standard Review once the content meets clinical standard after review.	<b>+ \$100</b>
<b>Volume Pricing</b>	For teams reviewing content across a client base, priced per piece at a minimum of 5 pieces per month.	<b>\$225 / piece</b>
<b>Standard Review</b>	A full clinical review of one piece (blog post, landing page, or product copy) up to 1,500 words: accuracy review, claims check, suggested edits, and a written review summary with recommendations.	<b>\$300</b>
<b>Monthly Retainer</b>	A flat monthly rate covering up to 6 pieces, for teams that prefer predictable billing over per-piece invoicing.	<b>\$1,000 / mo</b>
